The University of Mississippi is located in Oxford, Mississippi, a charming small town in the U.S. South. Oxford has a vibrant and creative community. Home to famous author William Faulkner, it boasts a rich literary tradition in addition to amazing music, arts, and cuisine.

> RESIDENCE HALL 3 (RH3)

Residence Hall 3 is a contemporary dormitory located on campus. The rooms are double occupancy, meaning that 2 students share a room and bathroom.

RH3 also features shared kitchen, laundry, and study/lounge areas.

> THE QUARTERS

The Quarters is an apartment-style living complex located a short bus ride (5 minutes) or a long walk (30 minutes) from campus.

Units feature four individual bedrooms. Each room has a private bathroom. A total of four roommates share a kitchen, laundry, and living area per unit.

The complex also features fun amenities such as a 24/7 gym, swimming pool, computer labs, and lounge areas.
